Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act

- <u>Legislation</u> signed into law on March 27
- Provides \$4 billion for Emergency Solutions Grants
 - \$1b allocated using FY20 formula
 - Remainder to be allocated using formula TBD by HUD
 - Based on factors including risk of transmission of coronavirus, rates of shelter/unsheltered homeless, and economic and housing market conditions
 - Allocation available within 90 days of enactment (June 25)
 - 10% admin cap
 - No match requirements
 - Allows HUD Secretary broad waiver authority
- COSCDA and other groups advocating for additional resources in next supplemental

Waivers and Support

- Waivers issued April 2 on ESG, HOPWA, CoC, and Con Plans
- 30-day to 5-day public comment period for Con Plan amendments
- Reasonable notice and opportunity to comment
- Re-evaluations for homeless assistance waived
- Waives limit on rental assistance to rents at or under FMR
- SNAPS hosting weekly office hours

Virginia

- 15 CoCs and BoS 12 LPGs immediate deficits supply needs
- Used health department, others sources to share social distancing strategies
- Determine costs for hotel rooms to house unsheltered and those who needed to vacate shelters during the day
- Total needed \$2.5m/week
- Navigating coupling ESG w. FEMA funds Wave 1 funding
- Looking to apply current CDBG to 40 communities (Ex. James City County – small locality w. high infection rate)
- Considering additional waivers for relief FMR and CM

Ohio

- Housing Crisis Response Program
 - Funds supplies, staffing, motel access
 - Grants up to 2 years emergency response
- CDBG Target Opportunity Fund
 - \$1 million available
 - Supports housing stability
 - Funds dedicated to shelters, supplies, staff, and motel vouchers
- OH Finance Agency
 - Homeless prevention/rapid re-housing
 - Emergency rental assistance

Health impact and Emergency Management Agency

Partnering with CoCs

- COHHIO Reserve Fund
 - \$1 mil raised

Colorado

- CDBG Formula
 - State distributes evenly between housing, infrastructure, and economic development
- Housing funds supporting acquisition of 1-2 motels
 - Emergency shelters
 - Diversion aiding social distancing practices
- Other uses of CDBG funds: supplies, business retention loans, emergency rental assistance
- Partnering w. local orgs. to prevent disease spread
- ESG used for master leasing w. hotels, CDBG long-term efforts w. permanent facilities
