COSCDA Environmental Review Training

This training is intended to help HUD grantees understand and fulfill the Federal environmental r equirements of their programs. This training is designed to assist state program staff with a deeper knowledge of environmental requirements and their role in reviewin g and monitoring ERR's.

COSCDA Acquisition and Relocation Training June 8, 2021 1:00pm – 4:30pm EDT Fee: \$249.00

This training expands on the material covered in CDBG Boot Camp to provide a high level revie w of the requirements of the URA. Attendees will engage in exercises and group discussions on the topic and be provided useful tools and resources that will better equip state sta ff to manage HUD funded projects that involve acquisition of real property, residential relocation, and non-residential relocation.

COSCDA Labor Standards Training June 9, 2021 8:30am – 12:00pm EDT Fee: \$249.00

This training is intended to help HUD grantees understand the requirements of Federal labor stan dards regulations on HUD funded construction projects. This training is designed to assist state program staff with a deeper knowledge of Davis Bacon and Related Acts and the state's role in reviewing and monitoring federal labor requirements.

COSCDA Fair Housing and Equal Opportunity Training (including 24 CFR Part 75) June 9, 2021 1:00pm – 4:30pm EDT Fee: \$249.00

This training expands on the material covered in CDBG Boot Camp of the requirements for state s to meet fair housing and equal opportunity requirements for their HUD funded programs. The training includes information on the new Section 3 rule (24 CFR Part 75), Affirm atively Furthering Fair Housing and other civil rights and equal opportunity requirements.
