Before COVID-19 Labor Statistics (Feb 2020)

- Arkansas Unemployment Rate: 3.5%
- Arkansas Labor Force: 1,367,278
- Employment: 1,319,479
- Unemployment: 47,779

More Arkansans working than ever before 107,000 more Arkansans working than in January of 2015



Current Labor Statistics (June 2020)

- Arkansas Unemployment Rate: 8% (April 10.8%)
- Arkansas Labor Force: 1,312,290
- Employment: 1,206,952
- Unemployment: 105,338 (April 140,898)
- United States Unemployment Rate: 11.1%



AEDC Programs | Initial COVID-19 Response

✓ \$10 Million CDBG Grants to 27 Rural Hospitals (Regular CDBG Allotment)

- Grants between \$250,000 \$500,000
- Public Service Activity Operational Costs/Equipment/Supplies
- Total employment: 7,899



- ✓ \$9 Million Quick Action Bridge Loan Program
 - \$3M from Attorney General's Consumer Education and Enforcement Fund – Bridge Loan Program
 - \$6M from Governor's Quick Action Closing Fund
 - Designed for small businesses across all industries in Arkansas with 2-50 employees to "bridge" to PPP loans
 - Number of companies benefitted: 483
 - \circ Number of jobs benefitted: 6,610

AEDC Programs | Ready for Business Grant Program

- ✓ Key Objectives
 - Assist companies with expenses related to reopening or resuming operations.
 - > Social distancing and PPE requirements strain already thin margins
 - > Businesses lacked working capital to restock and advertise
 - Create a sense of confidence for employees and customers that it was safe to return to business
 - Leverage \$1.25B in CFR allotment without duplicating PPP and other programs
- ✓ Challenges
 - $\,\circ\,$ Lack of data to assess financial need
 - Early ambiguity in CRF limitation payroll vs. nonpayroll
 - \circ Legislative support



AEDC Programs | Ready for Business Grant Program

✓ Program Parameters

- Grant = \$1000/FTE, up to \$100,000 per business owner
- $\,\circ\,\,$ Must expend funds between March 31-December 30, 2020
- $\circ~$ Only used for specified expenses
- $\,\circ\,\,$ Grant disbursed up front, with receipts submitted later
- $\,\circ\,\,$ Fraud prevention was a major concern
 - > Verify ID
 - > Tax clearance
- Small business set aside (under 50 employees) = 75%
- o MBE/WBE set aside = 15%
- ✓ Administration
 - 100% web-based application and grant management using Salesforce
 - Redeployed AEDC staff to work call center and review grant applications (while most worked from home)



AEDC Programs | Ready for Business Grant Program

- ✓ Round 1 (April 29) \$15 million allotment
 - $\,\circ\,\,$ Funds exhausted in 40 minutes
 - \circ \$22 million over-subscription
- ✓ Round 2 (May 5-6) \$40 million allotment
 - $_{\odot}$ \$92.7 million over-subscription
 - Additional appropriation added bringing total to \$147.7 million
- ✓ Business size and ownership of recipients:
 - Less than 50 employees: 94.4%
 - Minority-owned: 25.2%
 - o Women-owned: 33%
- ✓ Grants awarded to companies from all 75 counties
 - Number of companies benefitted: 11,409
 - Number of jobs benefitted: 225,000



AEDC Programs | What's Next?

- ✓ Audit expenses for Ready for Business
- ✓ Roll-out \$7.8 million PPP equivalent loan program for large non-profits that provide services to the developmentally disabled
