HUD	 Align environmental reviews for coastal/inland risk areas Ensure timely data in disaster response Expand waivers to include planning and housing activities
Congress	 Codify CDBG-DR and install reforms to improve program outcomes Extend the Disaster Recovery & Reform Act to leverage resources & address gaps in disaster response Expand flexibility under FEMA's Individual Assistance to enhance disaster aid
