

Program Strategy

Primarily serving the Non-Participating Jurisdiction

- Georgia has a diverse population structure
 - High amounts of Urban/Metro, Smaller Metro and Rural Areas
- Find areas large enough to sustain populations with needs but were not PJs who received HOME-ARP Funds

Support other Department's Programming

- Coordinated Entry System Funding (Coordinator Positions)
- Exploring Supportive Services to fill ESG Gaps


Research

- Ensure our strategy is as data-informed as possible
- · Review other examples from HUD and different states

Diverse Activities

- · Non-congregant shelters in multi-phased programs
- Rental Housing with all four QPs
- Permanent Supportive Housing Development
- Capacity Building & Training
 - Non-Congregate Shelter application weekly trainings for three-months
 - Supportive Housing Institute
 - Increase the opportunities for state partners to understand supportive housing
