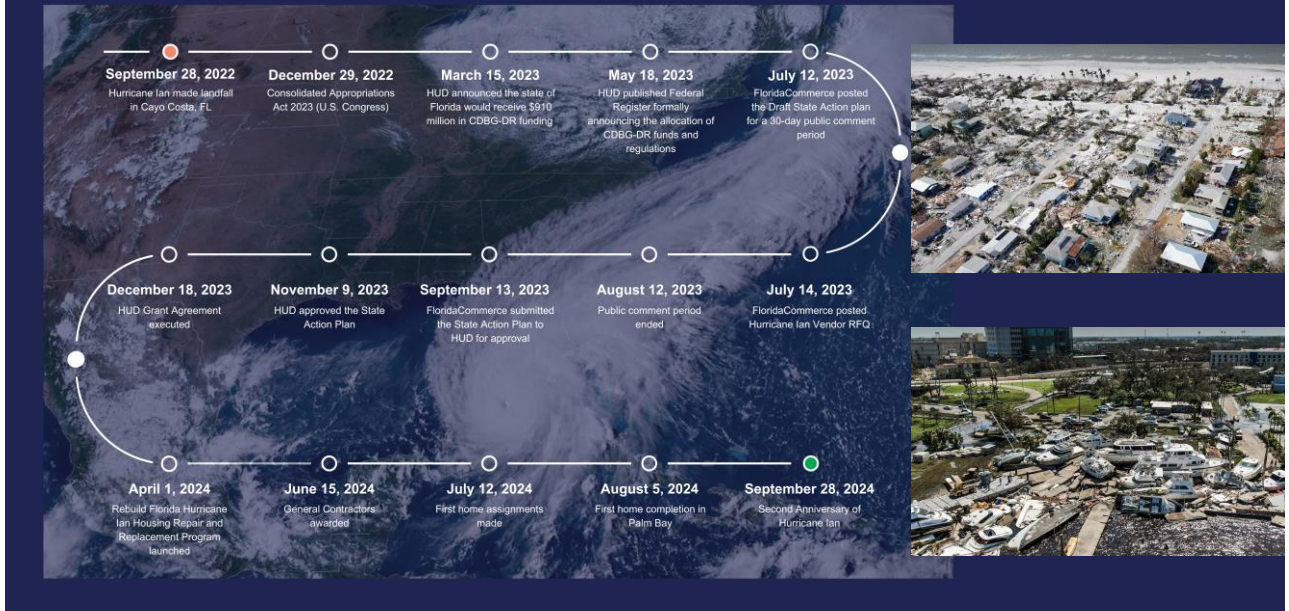

Allocation Breakdown

- On April 1, 2024, FloridaCommerce announced more than \$910 million available in funding to support Floridians following Hurricane Ian.
- \$542 million to the Housing Repair and Replacement Program.
