Initial Allocations during height of Covid pandemic/ CARES Act funds

MA receives about \$1M annually Partnered with MA DPH to identify uses/priorities.


> Installation of sprinklers in Sober Homes to maintain "certification status" identified initially – funded by State legislature at last minute

DPH identified need for rental vouchers for persons entering sober homes and residents who had lost income based on success of prior \$250k state allocation

> Pivoted to rental vouchers to pay weekly rent within certified sober homes for a period for up to 100 days or until the assisted individuals find permanent housing, for a max 3,000 K.





Fiscal Process Summary for EOHLC and BSAS Collaboration on the Rental Housing Program (RHP)

GOAL: Review each component, address any questions or outstanding issues, support alignment, clarify next steps



PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

LEligible applicants are any individual seeking rental funds for use in any certified Massachusetts Sober Home who has not previously exceeded \$3,000 in assistance.

2.Eligible applicants will have a demonstrated financial need.

3.Applications from persons with the greatest need will be prioritized based on qualitative and/or quantitative information from applicants that demonstrates a need for RHP funding.

4.The projected demand for the proposed temporary recovery housing solution and the financial need for assistance will also be considered.

5.Use of the voucher may be consecutive or intermittent.

6.Individual assistance is limited to \$3,000

7.Funds will be paid directly to the Sober Homes

8.The RHP activities, when taken as a whole, will not benefit moderate-income persons to the exclusion of low-income persons.
