Attendees will engage in exercises and group discussions on the topic and be provided with useful tools and resources that will better equip state staff to manage HUD funded projects that involve acquisition of real property, residential relocation, and non-residential relocation.

COSCDAC Labor Standards Training

This training is intended to help HUD grantees understand the requirements of federal labor standards regulations on HUD funded construction projects. This training is designed to assist state program staff with a deeper knowledge of Davis Bacon and Related Acts and the states' role in reviewing and monitoring federal labor requirements.
