Project & Grantee Information

- Cache County sponsored the purchase of a five to seven seat passenger vehicle
- This vehicle will be used to help serve domestic abuse/violence children by providing transportation to the center where children will receive coordinated services during the child abuse investigative process



Regional Rating & Ranking (RRC) - Project Choice

- The role of the RRC is to review and determine the rating & ranking of CDBG applications in each region of the state
- The RRC has the responsibility to determine threshold eligibility and consistency with Utah's consolidated plan
- The RRC is also responsible to ensure projects align with their regional needs and priorities
- Awards are determined and funded based on the region's priorities and the regional allocation amount



Results

Serving approximately 600 victims of domestic violence in Northern Cache Valley

- Hyde Park, North Logan, Trenton, Newton, Clarkston, Smithfield, Richmond, Lewiston, Cornish and Cove



Lessons Learned

The use of matrix code 05N requires careful management to ensure compliance, proper reporting, and accurate data tracking

- Complexity in distinguishing similar IDIS matrix codes – Categorization can be tricky
 - Strict definition limitations -**pay close attention to what is being provided or the activity type**
 - Examples
 - 05N – Provides specialized services for children who are abused or neglected
 - 05U – provides counseling
- Limited Scope: This is for the specific, delicate sub-population of abused and neglected children
 - Abused children are often considered "presumed benefit" clientele, but improper documentation can lead to data loss or audit findings during IDIS reporting
