Georgia's CDBG-DR Grants

2017 Allocation

- Initially funded: \$37,943,000
- Plus-Up (infrastructure specific): \$13,015,596

2018 Allocation

- Separated into child awards
 - Child Award 1: \$34,884,000
 - Child Award 2: \$6,953,000

2017/2018 MIT Allocation

- 2017: \$26,961,000
- 2018: \$2,669,000

2023 Tornado Allocation

- Initially funded: 12,595,000
- Plus-Up: \$9,346,000

2023-2024 Hurricanes Allocation

- Funded: \$265,726,000

Tips for Interested Departments

Programmatic Team

- Ensure policies and procedures align with each allocation for ease in compliance
- Cheat sheets for allocation-specific rules
- Use HUD waivers and suggested processes as much as feasible
- Separation of duties by allocation where possible

Finance Team

- Solid policies and procedures surrounding fund sources for allocations
- Share, share some more, and overshare programmatic information
- Reconciliation is crucial – monthly is preferred, but quarterly at a minimum
